A Look Back To Where It All Began

"Drinking good wine with good food with good company is life's most civilized pleasures."

The oldest proof of wine fermentation takes us back 8,000 years. Grape residue and wine remnants were discovered in clay jars in Georgia. Archeological proof of the birthplace of wine fermentation, cultivation and domestication was found in the Caucasus and Zagros Mountains, that extend from Eastern Turkey, and Armenia, through Georgia and the Middle East and also have the highest peaks in Europe. Fermented fruit waste was also discovered, indicative of this period in China's Yellow River Valley.

"The Temple Builders", an ancient and mysterious culture during the stone age period in the Maltese Islands left behind indications of wine consumption dating back to 4,000 BC. Two holes that were frequently carved into the floor of the temple's entrance may have been used to hold a ceremonial drink, possibly even wine.

Archeological evidence in a mountainous cave at the town of Areni in Armenia is thought to be the first ever winery. On the site, fermentation vats, cups, jars and a wine press was discovered.

Ancient Egypt and Greece have also played a role during the early discovery of wine. Due to the red wines' likeness to blood, grape culture in Egypt has possibly been introduced through the Levant connections with Turkey. Jars with wine residues were found buried with Scorpio and it is believed to be an amulet of the ancient times used to grant him passage to the afterlife. On the other side of the Mediterranean, in ancient Greece, it was Dionysus, the god of grape production and wine making that rose to prominence in mythology and the Greeks drank to him as vineyards grew and winemaking methods improved and wine became an integral aspect along with olive oil in Greek Culture. During the Reign of Alexander the Great, wine trade through the Aegean quickly expanded the reach of wine through the Roman Republic and the Iberic lands.

Locally, it was the Pheonicians that are credited with initiating the story of vinification on the Islands around 650 BC. The probability of the plantation of grapevines on the island is due to the long-established history of the Phoenicians and their wine cultivation prowess. After the Roman Republic gained control of Malta after the victory of Carthage in the first punic war, the Romans valued wine as a strategic resource that could substitute water as an act of conservation. Evidence of this can be found at the Domus Romana in Rabat where clay amphoras used for shipping and storing around the Mediterranean can be found on display.

Gellewza and Girgentina are the only two types of indigenous grapes that remain on the island. As the Roman Empire collapsed and with the arrival of the Arabs, wine production was reduced and only grapes that could be eaten survived this period.

- 201 Jean Parisot | Chardonnay € 80.00
(Ta' Betta Wine Estates, Il-Girgenti, Siggiewi, Malta)
White lemon colour, bright and intense viscosity. The nose shows hints of tertiary aromas, lactic (buttery, creamy, toasty), dried fruits (almonds), and spice (vanilla). The palate is dry medium to full-bodied, very well balanced oak. A great complex wine with a long aftertaste.
